SUBJECT: POLICY FOR TERM LIMITS FOR ALL UNIT AND GROUP COMMANDERS

Wing and Region Commanders serve a four year term. Squadron and Group Commanders will be allowed to serve a 4 year term, with an additional one year extension if approved by the Wing Commander. This last year will be used to groom a new Commander. Every Commander at every level, need to give a unit, group, wing or region a chance for fresh blood, ideas, growth and advancement by our membership. All of the other 7 Regions, currently have similar policies. The Rocky Mountain Region has few people and units spread out over a great area. If a remote unit will close because of this policy, then a waiver may be requested of the Region Commander, 3 months before the fifth year of a Squadron or Group Commanders term limit.
