SUMMARY: Rocky Mountain Region seeks motivated, dynamic, and experienced member to serve as the Region External Aerospace Education Officer.

REPORTS TO: Rocky Mountain Region Deputy Chief of Staff for Aerospace Education

FUNCTION: Plans, coordinates, supervises, and presents aerospace education opportunities to the public within the five Wings, especially to schools and other civic STEM organizations.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE (but are not limited to):

- Supporting and assisting the Wing level Directors of Aerospace Education and/or their External AEOs in the implementation of aerospace education programs and policies
- Developing relationships with like-minded partner organizations who participate in supporting aerospace, aviation, and STEM education
- Facilitating and supporting the recruitment of Aerospace Education Members into CAP
- Managing and supervising AE social media outlets to engage a wider community
- Serves as Deputy Director of the annual RMR Aerospace Education Conference
- Position will require reassignment to RMR-001 from current unit

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR POSITION:

- o Level III Complete Senior Member; may be Level II if professional educator
- o Technician rated in Aerospace Education track, working towards Senior rating
- o Yeager Award complete
- o General Emergency Services (101 card) holder with IS 100 and 200

IDEAL CANDIDATE WILL POSSESS (optional):

- o Experience as an educator; military, civilian, and CAP AEO experience will count
- o Mission Pilot, Observer, or Aircrew experience (CAP); military or civilian aircrew experience
- o Major or Master Sergeant and higher preferred; Captain, Senior Flight Officer, or TSgt may apply if meeting minimum requirements above
- o Bachelor's or Master's in STEM, education, and business related fields desired

EXPECTATIONS: Expect five to fifteen hours per week (varies), remote. Attendance at Region & RMR AE conference will be required. Expect about 10% travel to support Wing events in person.
